USER MANUAL – CAR TABLE (BOX TABLE FOR CAR)

Thank you for purchasing the car table. Please read this manual carefully before use.

1. Product purpose

The car table is intended for:

- stable placement of drinks and light items while the vehicle is stationary,
- storing food products in the refrigerator while the vehicle is stationary,
- storing light items in the cabinet.

The product is intended for use only as described above.

2. Safety rules

Strict prohibitions

1. Do not sit on the table.
2. Do not stand on the table.
3. Do not lie on the table.
4. Do not place body weight on the table.
5. Do not transport any products or items in the refrigerator while driving.
6. While driving, it is recommended to keep the cabinet empty and closed.
Transporting only light items in a closed cabinet is allowed, provided they are properly secured against movement.

Failure to follow these rules may result in:

- product damage,
 - vehicle damage,
 - personal injury,
 - loss of warranty.
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3. Table usage

- The table should only be unfolded and used when the vehicle is stationary.
- Before driving, ensure the table is folded and secured.
- Do not exceed the maximum load specified by the manufacturer.

- Only light items (e.g. cups, phone, documents) should be placed on the table.
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4. Refrigerator usage

- The refrigerator may only be used while the vehicle is stationary.
 - Before driving, remove all products and items from the refrigerator.
 - Do not place hot food inside when the cooling mode is active.
 - Clean the interior regularly with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
 - Do not immerse the device in water.
 - Follow the separate refrigerator manual included with the product.
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5. Maintenance and cleaning

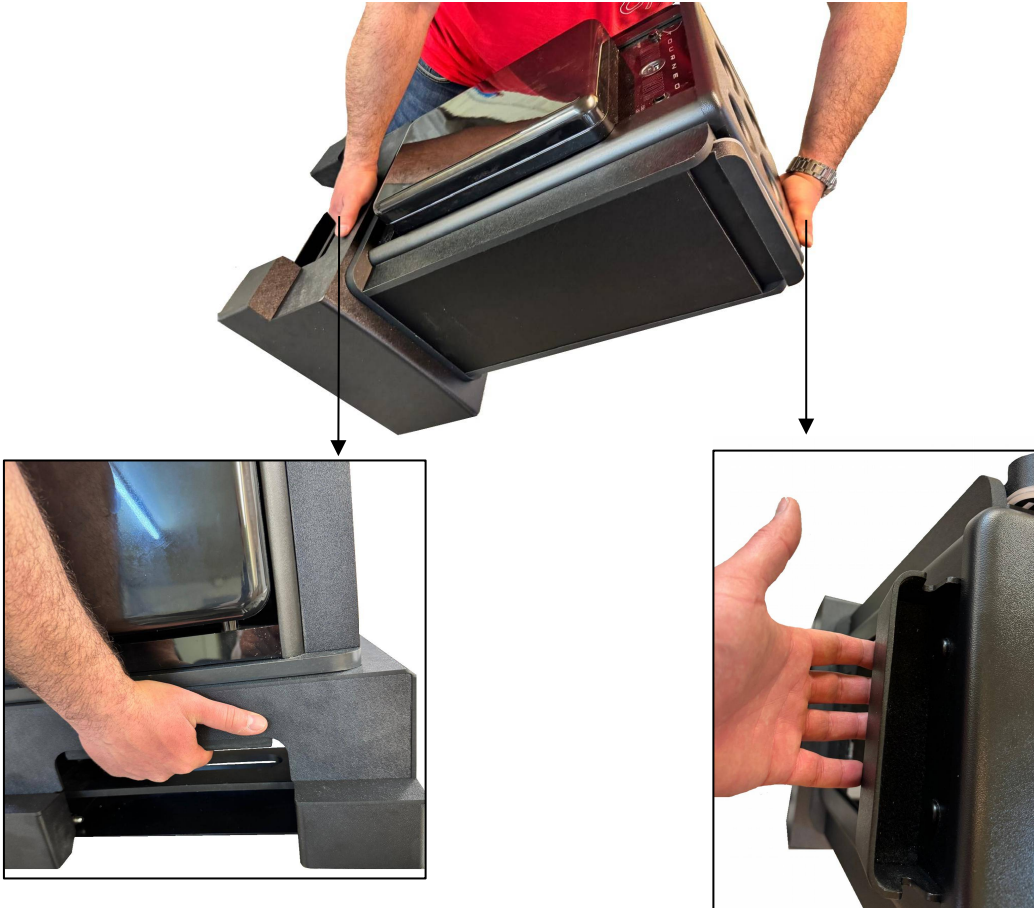
- Clean with a soft, damp cloth.
 - Do not use corrosive agents or solvents.
 - In case of damage, do not use the product until repaired.
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6. Liability

The manufacturer is not responsible for damages resulting from:

- improper use,
 - overloading the table,
 - using the product while driving in violation of safety rules.
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7. Safe handling



8. Table assembly:

1. Insert the table into the original mounting rails in the car.
2. Vigorously move the mounting strip (pushing it forward).



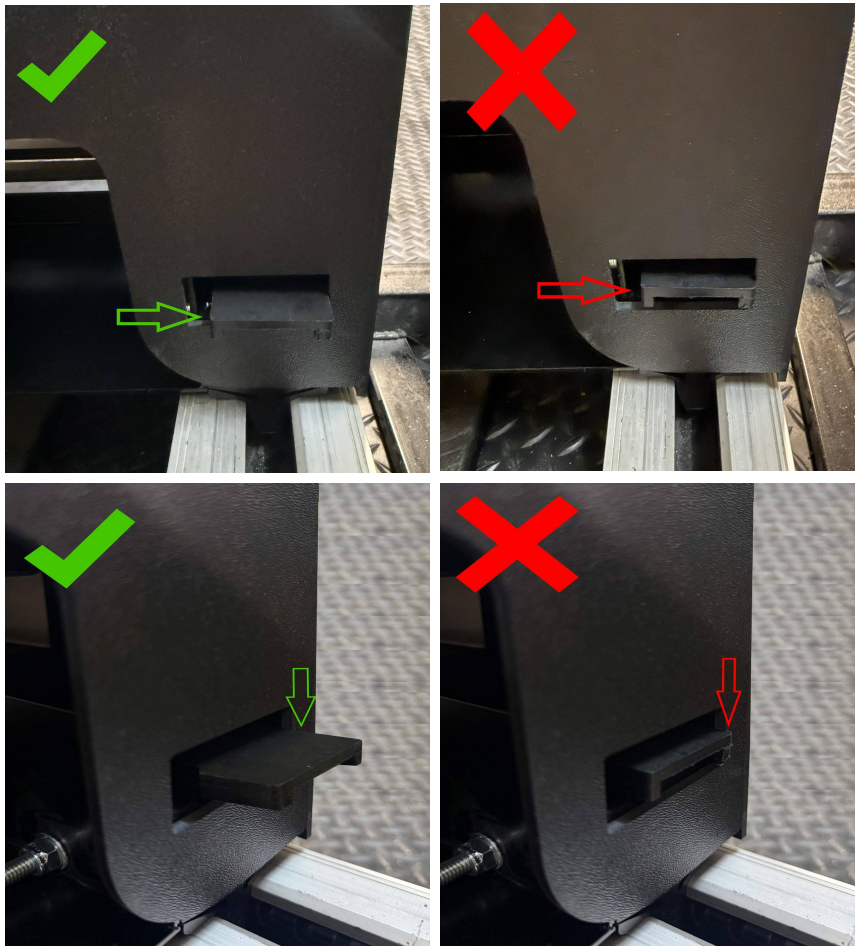
3. Check that the locking plates of equal length (**approx. 2 cm/0.8 in**) have been extended from the back of the table on both sides).



4. If the plates do not slide out or are too short:

1. move the table slightly forward,
2. press (push) the mounting strip at the same time,
3. make sure the latches are properly inserted into the teeth of the car rails.

5. The table is installed correctly when the locking plates are visible on both sides and are the same length.



Dismantling the table:

1. Pull the mounting strip towards you vigorously.
2. Pull until the locking plates on the back of the table are completely retracted.



3. The table is ready to be pulled out of the rails.
